## The Royal Tudor Beasts bull of clarence 2023 bullion coin range

The Royal Tudor Beasts bullion coin collection takes inspiration from ten majestic beasts that line the approach to Hampton Court Palace. Originally commissioned to commemorate the marriage of Henry VIII and Jane Seymour, each stone sentinel is a testament to royal bloodlines, designed to fortify the ambitious House of Tudor.

Following the Lion of England and Yale of Beaufort, the third coin in the collection features the Bull of Clarence. Representing strength and wealth, the heraldic Bull of Clarence was specifically chosen to join the King's Beasts on the Moat Bridge to emphasise Henry VIII's ancestral links to the powerful Yorkist dynasty.

David Lawrence's dynamic new design for the Bull of Clarence 2023 bullion coin places the bull against a background that resembles chain mail and includes surface animation, which provides an additional security feature. The obverse features the official coinage portrait of His Majesty The King by Martin Jennings for the first time in the series.

Struck to bullion standard, this coin is available in fine gold, silver and platinum editions.
