First struck in 1489 at the behest of Henry VII, The Sovereign has always been closely associated with the British monarchy. A symbol of reliability and strength, it is The Royal Mint's flagship coin and one of the most trusted bullion coins in the world.

This special edition of The Sovereign celebrates the coronation of His Majesty King Charles III. Created by British sculptor Martin Jennings, a crowned coinage portrait of His Majesty The King that received the monarch's personal approval appears on the obverse of the coin, whilst the reverse features Benedetto Pistrucci's depiction of St George and the dragon, which is synonymous with The Sovereign.
